

Miss Boss Cowman Rodeo Queen Contest

Rules

- Contestant applications must be **post marked** by July 1. The only exception will be in an age bracket that does not have three or more contestants. Then applications will be excepted up to the third contestant in the area.
- The sponsor money of \$25.00 must be submitted with the application.
- Any contestant that 'holds up' the contest by having to be called more than one time will receive an automatic point deduction of 2 points/time. **This includes being late for the contestant meeting.** We will be running 'on time' and the judges will be given 5 minutes maximum to write down their comments and such between each contestant in each event.
- **All contestants must be in cowboy boots and a cowboy hat during the whole contest.**
- Each contestant must wear **blue** jeans and a **white**, western shirt during horsemanship. The wardrobe for the other areas of the contest should be western attire, but style will be left up to the contestant. During the modeling the contestant may wear colored jeans, but a western dress or skirt is encouraged
- All age level of contestants may use spurs and tie downs during horsemanship. Only the princess level contestants may use a roping rein. All contestants may use the bit of their choice.
- During the modeling, each contestant will be asked to answer an impromptu question. The queen contestants will **also** be asked a question dealing with a current event.
- Each contestant will give a prepared speech before modeling her outfit.
- It is the responsibility of the titleholders or their family to provide transportation of the horse, and all necessary items for the required appearances.
- The titleholders must have their own horse or full use of one during their reign.
- The titleholders will be **required** to attend all the Boss Cowman Rodeos and the rodeo slack where they will also be asked to help with the "cleaning" of the arena. They will be **required** to ride in the parade on Saturday (all contestants are welcome). They are **required** to be at as many events as possible during the Boss Cowman celebration. This includes the current year and the next year's events up to the crowning on Friday night (i.e. Boss Cowman Honoree dinner-it is common for the titleholders to help with the serving of the honorees).
- It will also be the responsibility of the titleholders to help with the organizing of and to be the spokespersons for the queen contest the following year. The titleholders will be responsible for collecting the sponsorship for the prizes in their area (queen, jr. queen or princess).
- Age levels are as follows:
 - Princess- through 9 years old as of July 1st
 - Jr. Queen-10 through 14 years old as of July 1st
 - Queen- 15 through 23 years old as of July 1st
